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This House Is Clean Disinfecting Your Workspace With Airless Sprayers

With the onset of CoVid19 and all the rising health and safety concerns, it is now more important than ever that your business provide a safe work environment for both your employees and clients.

Airless sprayers provide high production rates allowing Remediation/Disinfectant contractors to get jobs done faster with better coverage.

To use an airless spray gun, our partners at <u>Titan</u> suggest the following for best results:

- Utilize a unit with flow rates between 0.47 GPM to 1.25 GPM. Titan offers the <u>Impact 410</u>, <u>Impact 440</u>, or the <u>Elite 3000</u> sprayers to do the job.
- Use a low-pressure spray tip, if available. Titan recommends their <u>TR1 HEA Tips.</u>
- Firmly tighten the connections on the device and check the seal using water before adding any disinfectant.
- Remove the water, then place your disinfectant of choice into the hopper or insert the suction system directly into the disinfectant container.



The EPA recommends the following compounds for best results:

- Alcohol –based
- Aldehydes
- ◊ Biguarides
- o Diamidines
- o Peroxygens
- Phenolics
- Quaternary ammonium
- Halogen-releasing compounds
- Sodium hypochlorite (Bleach)
- Hydrogen Peroxide



Titan's Full Line Of Recommended Sprayers

- Set Pressure at between 500 and 1000psi
- Spray larger areas quickly, spray smaller details efficiently and thoroughly

Be sure to include:

- Dining areas
- Lockers, locker rooms, and employee break areas
- Restrooms
- Fitness rooms
- Stairwells and railings
- All doors and door handles
- Flush the system thoroughly with water immediately after use or during any work interruptions. Many of these cleaning solutions are highly corrosive and should never be left in the pumps more than 15 minutes after use.

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Some additional elements to consider:

- Your sprayer should ideally stay outside of the area being actively disinfected if it has a hose with it. This is to best ensure the sprayer and disinfectant container do not get contaminated.
- Consult with disinfectant manufacturers about the suitability of a paint sprayer or other equipment to spray disinfectant.
- Consider the need for a respirator and other proper PPE. Each disinfectant will have its own requirements.



- Some substances may have a tendency to streak or leave marks on electronics, stainless steel appliances and other surfaces. Use caution and apply a small amount to test before full application.
- Ensure the necessary amount of disinfectant is applied, the dwell time is appropriate, and any additional steps required are followed.
- If spraying alcohol-based or flammable products, the spray device should always be located at least 15 feet outside of the hazard zone at all times.

Safety in the workplace should be your number one priority. Securing your customers' safety will add to their peace of mind and ensure their continued business. Going above and beyond to ensure your employee's safety will lend itself to continued loyalty and employee retention.
